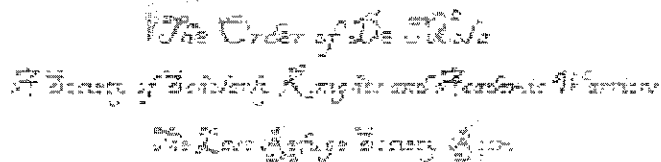
1) Men from the colonies are meeting to decide what to do about Great Britain. What qualities, skills, and achievements do you think these men should have?

6) How did the Massachusetts soldiers surprise the British at Breed's Hill?


7) Who was Paul Revere? What did he famously do?
