
Using ROOT CLUES

The roots aqua (water) and terr (land) give you clues about meaning. When you spot one of these roots in a word, you have a key to the word's meaning. Use the underlined root clues to help you match the following columns:

AQUA (from the Latin word aqua meaning "water")



1. aquatic (ə kwa' tik) adj. Living in, or having to do with, water.

Whales, dolphins, shrimp, and guppies are all aquatic creatures.

2. aquamarine (ä' kwə mə rēn) adj. A bluish-green color.

We watched as the artist mixed small amounts of both blue and green paints to make just the right shade of aquamarine for the seascape.




3. aquaculture (ä' kwa kal char)

n. The science of raising plants and animals in water.

To see how aquaculture worked, we visited an oyster farm on the coast of Maine.

TERR (from the Latin word terra meaning "land")



4. Mediterranean (me de te rā' nē en) n. A large sea between two continents, southern Europe and northern Africa.

At the western end of the Mediterranean Sea is the Strait of Gibraltar.

NOTA BENE


5. subterranean (səb tə rā' nē ən) adj. Under the earth.

6. terrace (ter/es)

n. 1. An area of ground on the side of a hill that has a flattened top in order to grow things.

We could see terraces all the way up the hillside where farmers had planted their crops.



2. A platform built out from a house; a patio.

In good weather, our family often eats outside on the terrace.

7. terrain (†a rān')

n. Land or ground.

The truck bumped along on the rough terrain of the field until it reached a paved road on the other side.



8. territory (ter' a tor ē)

n. A large area of land, a region; a settlement or colony.

In 1803 the United States purchased the Louisiana Territory, which added about eight hundred thousand square miles of land to the country.
